### Return to School

As of Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June school will reopen for Reception, Year 1, Year 6 and key worker children only. Nursery have not been included at this time as we are not able to make sure children and staff will be able to maintain a safe distance, plus the cleaning required for 2 groups of children in a single classroom is not manageable. The classes coming back are only able to do so because all staff have been allocated groups and we do not have any additional staff or classrooms to be able to cater for other year groups at this time. **If a staff member over the next few has to self-isolate we will have to inform relevant parents for that group that the children will not be able to attend school while we wait for the staff member to return.** We have many staff that are unable to work due to underlying medical conditions or are required to self-shield to protect their family members. If your child is eligible to return to school but they are vulnerable or shielding, then they should continue to shield at home. Your child returning to school is optional. We have spoken to the majority of parents in those year groups and I understand your fears about returning too soon, I want to be very clear that returning is **not compulsory** and you will not be penalised for non-attendance.

As parents, we will need your full co-operation if you choose to return your child to school in order for us to lower the risk of infection. Please discuss with your child that school will not be the same as it was in March. Discuss with them these points:

- We will be encouraging social distancing between children and staff.
- We have reduced class sizes to a maximum of 15. That group of 15 pupils will only be able to mix together and will avoid contact with the other groups of 15 in the school.
- Children will only use the 1 classroom. Movement around the school will be infrequent and limited.
- The children may have a different class teacher (see pupil/teacher allocations below)
- Staff may be wearing PPE equipment including masks and gloves.
- Children must clean their hands with soap and water frequently throughout the day.
- Children to try not touching their mouth, eyes and nose.
- Children to use a tissue when they cough or sneeze and to put the tissue into a bin.
- Classrooms look different, tables and chairs have been separated to allow for distancing
- Each pupil will have a separate desk and chair.
- Stationary and equipment is not to be shared between pupils.

- Lunch times and break times will be staggered, so children will not be able to mix outside of their group. Balls are not to be brought in from home.
- Children can only play in 1 area of the playground with their group of 15.
- If a child is unwell with a continuous cough or high temperature, they will have to wait in the Maths Room whilst waiting to be collected.
- Children must adhere to the school discipline policy, including the new measures of maintaining health and hygiene and social distancing where possible.
- In Early Years activities will be limited so they can't spread the virus.

As parents, we will need your full co-operation if you choose to return your child to school in order for us to lower the risk of infection. On the school website is the Covid-19 drop down with all relevant documents I would like you to look through the amended Discipline policy and Health & Safety Policy.

- **Parents, carers or children must not enter school if they are displaying any symptoms of coronavirus**
- Only 1 adult can accompany a child to school.
- A parent/carer cannot approach a member of staff before or after school. If you have a query, you must phone the office and the member of staff will speak to you when they are available.
- Parents cannot gather at entrance gates or doors.
- Parents must stay 2m away from the children when they are lined up on the playground at the start and end of the day. We will maintain the same routine even if it is raining as we will not be allowing children to come inside early.
- At the end of the day, children will be lined up on the playgrounds. Parents must stand 2m away and the teacher will ask the child to wave at the adult who has come to collect them. The child will then walk towards the parent.
- Parents cannot come into the school building unless an appointment has been requested by telephone first
- Children must attend in clean uniform/clothes each day.

If anyone becomes unwell with a new, continuous cough or a high temperature in school, they must be sent home. We have a contactless thermometer to check their temperature with and they will be moved to the Maths room where they can be isolated behind a closed door with appropriate adult supervision if required.

When a child or staff member develops symptoms compatible with coronavirus, they will be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 7 days. Their fellow household members should self-isolate for 14 days. All staff and children have access to a test if they display symptoms of coronavirus, and are encouraged to get tested as quickly as possible so we can determine if it is positive or negative case.

Where the child or staff member tests negative, they can return to school when well and the fellow household members can end their self-isolation.

Where the child or staff member tests positive, the rest of their group will be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 14 days. The other household members of that wider class or group do not need to self-isolate unless the child, young person or staff member they live with in that group subsequently develops symptoms.

Here is the list of staff and groups your child has been allocated with, these are non-negotiable as we cannot mix groups up once started. We have heard from many parents since this original list went out who have said they don't want the place which is totally understandable, they have been included in case parents change their mind.

**Reception**

Start 9:00am and finish at 2:55pm

Children will line up on the KS1 playground at the start of the day.

Children with Miss Smith and Mrs Patterson will need to be collected from the Reception playground.

Children with Miss Bemand and Miss Corbett will need to be collected from the KS1 playground.

All packed lunches and toast at break time will be provided by the school. Do not send in any food with your child. All children will need to bring in their own water bottle.
