Return to School for September 3rd

It has been a fantastic week in school, seeing so many children come back who are enthusiastic and enjoying learning. I want to thank the parents I have spoken to for all the positive feedback they have given over the last few weeks, it has been wonderful to pass on the comments to the teachers. I also want to thank all the parents for all their hard work over the last few months, I know as a parent myself how challenging it has been to home school, routines have been difficult to maintain and juggling work commitments alongside them has meant it has been a strain on all families across the country. This is why I am excited that the Government are allowing schools to fully reopen as of September, albeit with similar procedures we currently have in place to maintain a safe working environment.

School will open for all pupils on **Thursday 3rd September** for all Year 1 to 6 pupils, new Reception and Nursery pupils will start at different times throughout September.

The same procedures we have adopted now will have to continue, with some slight changes to allow for 30 children per class. Guidance from the DfE state these procedures will need to continue for at least the Autumn Term and even further if a new lockdown happens due to a local or national spike of the virus. If we are unable to open for any reason then I will inform parents as soon as possible, but I must reiterate I only find out any news at the same time as you do.

As parents, we will need your full co-operation for us to maintain and lower the risk of infection. Discuss with them these points:

- We will be encouraging social distancing between children and staff (1+ metres). Some staff members are on the vulnerable list and although allowed back to work they **must** stay 2 metres away from all pupils and other staff members.
- Children will come back into their year groups and each year group which consists of 60 children. Each year group is a bubble and are not able to mix with other year groups. The Government do not expect children in their individual year bubbles to social distance from each other, so Maths sets can resume.
- Movement around the school will be infrequent and limited to a one way system to avoid cross overs in corridors.

- Children must clean their hands with soap and water frequently throughout the day.
- Children to try not touching their mouth, eyes and nose.
- Children to use a tissue when they cough or sneeze and to put the tissue into a bin.
- Classrooms look different, tables and chairs have been separated to allow for distancing, all children have to face the front of the class.
- Stationery and equipment can be shared between pupils in their class, although if parents want to supply personal equipment then they may do so.
- Lunch times and break times will be staggered, so children will not be able to mix outside of their year groups. Balls can be brought in from home but must only be used by their year group.
- Children can only play in 1 area of the playground, the playground will be split into two to allow 2 years groups out at one time.
- If a child is unwell with a continuous cough or high temperature or loss of smell and taste, they will have to wait in the Maths Room whilst waiting to be collected.
- Children must adhere to the school discipline policy, including the new measures of maintaining health and hygiene and social distancing where possible.
- In Early Years activities will be limited so they can't spread the virus.

On the school website is the 'Coronavirus Update' drop down with all relevant documents I would like you to look through the amended Discipline Policy and Health & Safety Policy. Over the last few weeks I have had to remind some parents of the conditions that I have had to put in place to allow staff to come to work they include:

- **Parents, carers or children must not enter school if they are displaying any symptoms of coronavirus**
- Only 1 adult can accompany a child to school.
- Children must be dropped off in the playground at their allotted time, when a child is brought late to the front office I have to walk them through school which is a risk to social distancing guidance and bubbles being broken.
- Children must be collected on time.
- A parent/carer cannot approach a member of staff before or after school. If you have a query, you must phone the office and the member of staff will speak to you when they are available.
- Parents cannot gather at entrance gates or doors.
- Parents must stay 2m away from the children when they are lined up on the playground at the start and end of the day. We will maintain the same routine even if it is raining as we will not be allowing children to come inside early.
- At the end of the day, children will be lined up on the playgrounds. Parents must stand 2m away and the teacher will ask the child to wave at the adult who has come to collect them. The child will then walk towards the parent.
- Parents cannot come into the school building unless an appointment has been requested by telephone first
- Children must attend in clean uniform each day.

If anyone becomes unwell with a new, continuous cough or high temperature in school or loss of taste and smell, they must be sent home. We have a contactless thermometer to check their temperature

with and they will be moved to the Maths room where they can be isolated behind a closed door with appropriate adult supervision if required.

When a child or staff member develops symptoms compatible with coronavirus, they will be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 7 days. Their fellow household members should self-isolate for 14 days. All staff and children have access to a test if they display symptoms of coronavirus, and are encouraged to get tested as quickly as possible so we can determine if it is positive or negative case.

Where the child or staff member tests negative, they can return to school when well and the fellow household members can end their self-isolation. When tested you will receive a letter determining what then outcome is. We need to know what the outcome is to report to Public Health England as school can be instructed to close if a local spike or if an isolated spike occurs within school.

Where the child or staff member tests positive, the rest of their group will be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 14 days. The other household members of that wider class or group do not need to self-isolate unless the child, young person or staff member they live with in that group subsequently develops symptoms.

We have a new lunchtime supplier called Dolce who will be providing school dinners from September. They will contact parents via email to set you up with an individual account that means you can order and pay for school dinners online. Children that wish to have packed lunches from home can still do so. Children in Reception and KS1 are currently still able to have a Universal Free School Meal which is provided for free. This is not to be confused with families that require a Free School Meal due to their personal situation, if a family does they will need to prove they are in receipt of Universal Credit and will need to come into school to discuss this or go to this website <https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/birmingham/> and process an application online.

If children wish to purchase toast and drink for morning playtime they can do, they will need to order it in class at the start of the day so staff can collect it ready for playtime. Toast cost 20p per slice and a fruit drink costs 30p.

CKs will be open in September for Before and After School Club. They will be split between Rec/KS1 and KS2 year groups, so that bubbles are effectively made to reduce contact. If a parents wish to arrange before and after school care then they need to contact CK Managers Mrs Bye or Miss Hillier on 0121 6756689.

Here is the list of the classes your child/ren have been allocated with for next year, these are non-negotiable as we cannot mix classes up once arranged. The children in school today will have been notified and a text message will go out for all others to read this newsletter on the school website today so parents can tell children at home. Alongside the class lists I ask you to take note of the individual start and end times for your child as they differ between each year group.

Reception

Children will line up and be collected from the Reception playground.

All children will need to bring in their own water bottle.

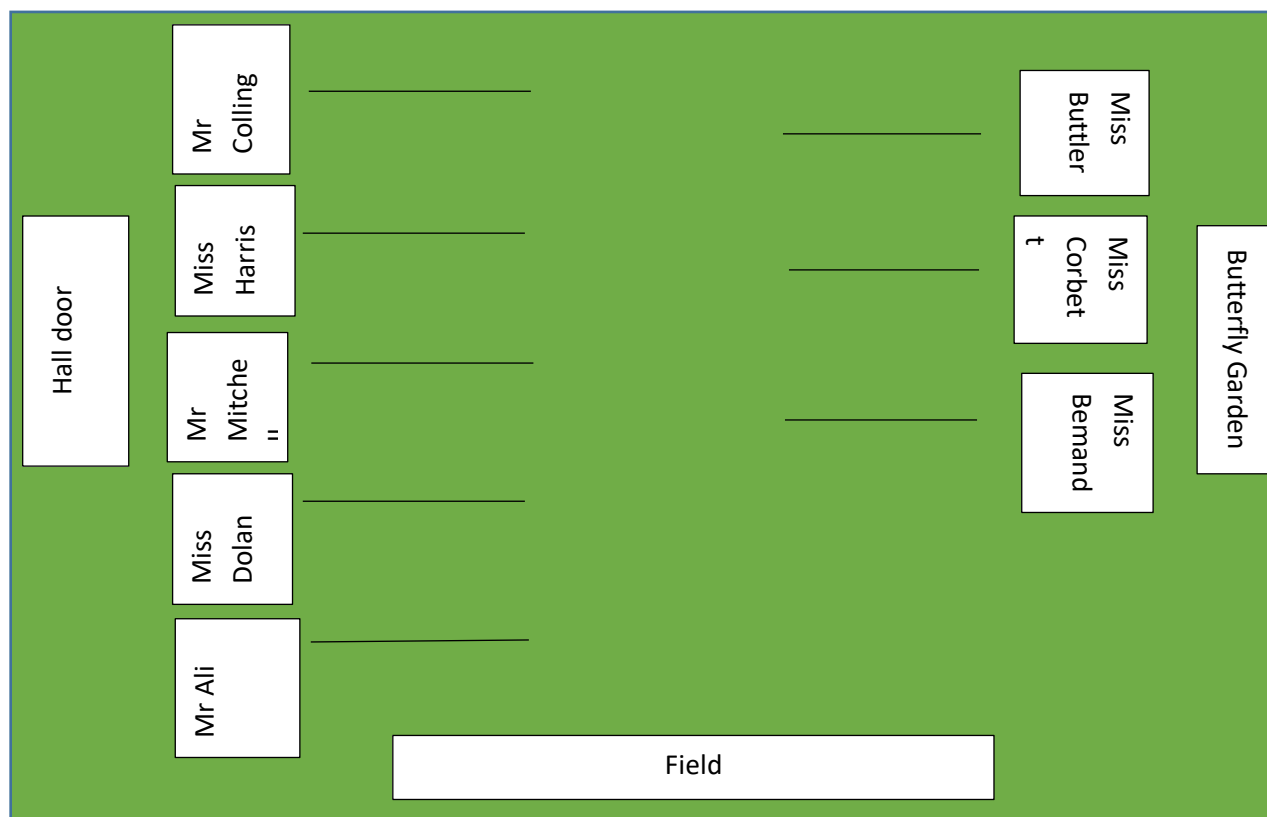
