Sun Hats and Sun Cream

Regular attendance is critical not only for academic success but also for your child's social and emotional development. Being in school enables children to:

- Develop good punctuality and other essential habits for a successful future.

To help put this in perspective, here's how different attendance rates affect missed learning:

Days Absent	Weeks Missed	Lessons Missed

5 days	1 week	25 lessons
10 days	2 weeks	50 lessons
20 days	4 weeks	100 lessons

Persistent absence is when a pupil misses 19 days (10%), or more, of their possible school days. If you wish to discuss any issues affecting your child's attendance, please contact school.

School Fayre

The school Summer Fayre is next week and will take place on Friday 4th July between 3.45-5.00pm in the Key Stage 2 playground. On this day, all children in Years One to Six will need to be collected from the Key Stage 1 playground at the end of the school day (as the gates to the KS2 playground will be locked until the fayre is ready to open at 3.45pm). Years One and Two will leave as usual at 3.20pm. Years Three and Four will come out of the red doors by the office at 3.25pm, Years Five and Six will come out of the KS1 red doors at 3.25pm.
