

Autumn 1 – The Surprising Stone Age and Me

Our topic this half term is The Surprising Stone Age and Me. We will be looking at how people have changed over time by looking back at the Stone and Bronze Age then looking at our own lives today.

Across the curriculum we will be studying:

- How people lived during the Stone Age
- Developments in technology and civilisation during the Bronze Age
- Understanding our emotions
- Earth Rocks! (Science)

In English, we will be studying texts such as 'Stone Aged Boy', 'Ug!' and 'How to wash a woolly mammoth', where we will go on a time travelling adventure, in order to create wonderful work full of adjectives, descriptive openers and super SPAG!

In Maths, this half term we are learning about:

- Find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number
- Recognise the place value of digits
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write numbers
- Solve number problems
- Add and subtract numbers mentally
- Column addition and subtraction
