Birmingham Admissions Team have asked that we remind parents of the importance of applying online for their child's Reception place by visiting www.birmingham.gov.uk/schooladmissions. They can also call 0121 303 1888 and speak to a member of the team for further advice. In the meantime, the School Admissions Team will continue to process late applications up until 31st July 2026 to ensure children have a Reception class place for September 2026.
