Reception will remain open, as the Reception Induction meetings are held in the Main Hall. Letters with all the information have been sent to both sets of future Calshot parents.

## School Fayre

The school Summer Fayre is fast approaching and I wanted to let you know that the School Team are organising and arranging the big summer event. School Fayre will take place on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July between 3.45-5.00pm** in the Key Stage 2 playground. **On this day, all children in Years One to Six will need to be collected from the Key Stage 1 playground at the end of the school day** (as the gates to the KS2 playground will be locked until the fayre is ready to open at 3.45pm). Years One and Two will leave as usual at 3.20pm. Years Three and Four will come out of the red doors by the office at 3.25pm, Years Five and Six will come out of the KS1 red doors at 3.25pm.

On Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July, the children can wear non-school uniform and in return bring in either an unopened bottle or a chocolate bar to contribute to the school fayre prize fund. We request that Early Years and KS1 children bring in a chocolate bar and KS2 children bring in a bottle for the bottle stall.

## Sun Hats and Sun Cream

A reminder that children can bring sun hats to wear outside and will need a water bottle in school. We ask parents to apply sun cream before school so the children are protected throughout the day whilst outside.
