### Parent Questionnaire Overview

I would like to say a **BIG** thank you to all the **180 parents** who took time to complete the parent questionnaire. As a school this provides us with confirmation of what we are doing well and also makes us aware of any areas which could be improved. Two weeks on Monday, the questionnaire will be shared with the Full Governing Body.

- 99% of parents agree or strongly agree that their **child is happy at school**
- 98% of parents agree or strongly agree that their **child feels safe at school**
- 99% of parents agree or strongly agree that their **child is making good progress at school**
- 100% of parents agree or strongly agree that their **child is well looked after at school**
- 99% of parents agree or strongly agree that their **child is taught well at school**
- 95% of parents agree or strongly agree that their **child receives appropriate homework for their age**
- 95% of parents agree or strongly agree that the **school makes sure its pupils are well behaved and deals effectively with unacceptable behaviour**
- 99% of parents agree or strongly agree that the **school is well led and managed**
- 98% of parents agree or strongly agree that the **school responds well to any concerns that they raise**
- 97% of parents agree or strongly agree that they **receive valuable information from the school about their child's progress**
- 78% of parents agree or strongly agree that they **know who the governors are and what they do**
- 99% of parents said that they **would recommend the school to another parent**
